## TOURIST / BUSINESS VISA

-----

- 1- A valid passport for at least six months;
- 2- Two individual visa application forms filled and signed by the Applicant (copies, errors, alterations, omissions, inappropriate signature will be subject to refusal.
- 3- Two recent ID photos.
- 4- An invitation letter from the correspondent in Côte d'Ivoire, with his(her) name , surname, address and contact numbers as well as the visit purpose;
- 5- A hotel reservation or a legal accommodation certificate from the town council of the correspondent's city, or a proof of residence in Côte d'Ivoire (residence card, bank card);
- 6- Evidence of plane ticket reservation;
- 7- Valid proof of yellow fever and cholera immunization;
- 8- For children, annex the following documents:

- a. Legal parental authorization from one of the two parents (if the child is traveling alone);
- b. Ivorian birth certificate (if the child is born in Côte d'Ivoire), or an international birth certificate (if born out of Côte d'Ivoire);
- c. A certificate of right of care for the legal representative, when applicable.

**N.B:**

- 1- Visas issued by the Embassy can not exceed a validity period of 30 days;
- 2- The visa application is processed within a period of eight (08) working days;
- 3- Rejection of application are not subject to any explanation or justification;
- 4- No refund.
